Kathryn's professional history has been in Social Work and Early Childhood Services as well as media roles at Radio 2UE and Channel 10.

From 1995-2004 Kathryn was an elected Councillor to the Sydney City Council. She is the recipient of an Order of Australia (AO).

Kathryn is currently Chair of Luminesce Alliance and is a Board Director on the Menzies Leadership

Foundation, Paul Ramsay Foundation, Relationships Australia (NSW) and the Australian Academy of Music.

Kathryn holds a Bachelor of Social Work (UNSW) Certificate in Early Childhood (Macquarie University) and was awarded a Doctor of Letters (Honoris Causa) from UNSW.
